



Dear participant,

we are very happy to welcome you to the 17th Rock That Swing Festival. Below you will find all the important information about the Rock That Swing Festival. Please read everything carefully!



COLLECTION OF YOUR ORDER

The eletronic tickets for the evening events and the electronic vouchers for pickup of Dance Camp wristbands, **T-shirts and CDs** are sent to the email address of your order. You can also login to the order system and download the tickets and vouchers from there or re-send them to your email address.

EVENING TICKETS (PARTIES)

If you have only ordered evening tickets, you don't have to come to the check-in! You can go straight to the party with your electronic ticket (either printed or on your mobile device)!

If you have ordered tickets also for others, please make sure that each guest presents their own ticket. Each ticket code can only be scanned once!

DANCE CAMP

If you join the Dance Camp you need to pick up your wristbands at the check-in counter during opening hours. Additional bookings are only possible at the check-in.

To pick up your wristbands you will need your Dance Camp voucher (printed out or on mobile device) + student ID if you ordered with student discount!

Please, remember that you also have to go to your class room, which may take some time. Even if you're late, you have to go the Check-In first! So, if you arrive at the Check-In shortly before the start of the class, you won't be able to make it in time.

You can find the Dance Camp timetable with classes and studios on our website. At the check-in you will get a printed Dance Camp booklet that also holds a map with the check-in, all studios and event locations. It is also available as PDF for download on our website. On the website you can also access the Mobile Schedule which has integrated route planning and displays the class descriptions.

T-SHIRTS & RTSF CDS

Pick-up of ordered T-Shirts and CDs is only possible at the RTSF Merchandise Booth at first floor of the CVJM. It is next to the check-in counter.

For pick-up you will need your T-shirt or CD voucher (printed out or on mobile device).

CHECK-IN

The check-in is the central contact point for all your Rock That Swing matters and pick-ups. It is located at CVJM, Landwehrstr. 13, 80336 Munich. In important cases you can reach the check-in at +49 (157) 541 795 10.

This year we already open on Wednesday evening. If you have time come earlier or the evening before and avoid the longer pickup lines on Friday and Saturday mornings.

If you don't have your vouchers with you, the pick-up process will take much longer for you, because we will need to check your ID or passport at a special counter and search your order. This means, you'd have to queue twice. So, don't forget your vouchers! If you can not find your email with the vouchers, login to the online order system via the website and download it.

RTSF MERCHANDISE BOOTH

RTSF Merchandise can be found at the RTSF Booth next to the day check-in at the CVYM. A limited selection is also available at the foyer of the Deutsches Theater. Pick up of pre-ordered items is only possible at the booth located in CVJM.

PLAYBILL

Gosia has created a wonderful playbill again. The online version is already available on the website. You can get the printed version at the check-in and at the evening event locations. The playbill also contains the schedules of the evening events.

TICKET AVAILABILITY

Tickets are still available for the After Hours on Thursday night. All other nights are sold out. If any tickets becomes available than the tickets will be available from Wednesday at the Check-In or the respective box offices.

VINTAGE MARKET

From Thursday evening to Sunday evening you can stock up at the Vintage Market at the CVJM. You can also visit the market if you are not attending the RTSF. More information and opening hours can be found in the program booklet and on the website.

STYLING LOUNGE

Many people already know Patricia Valente from other festivals. This year she will also be offering a Styling Lounge in the CVJM (at the Check-In) on Saturday and Sunday. Check the website or the playbill for more info.

FOOD AND DRINKS

It is common sense, but we want to stress it again:

It is not permitted to bring your own food or drinks into the evening events, also no water!

If you get caught you will be expelled from the event.

The caterers need to pay the salary of their staff and the rent. We don't want to do any bag control and rather trust you to play fair. In case you see someone with their own bottle, please remind them to play fair, so we can continue having parties in those great locations.

BACKPACKS, BIG BAGS, SUITCASES

Due to fire regulations and limited space, **you cannot bring large bags, backpacks, or suitcases into the evening venues**. You can only take in smaller bags for your shoes and towels. The Künstlerhaus and the Deutsches Theater have a guarded cloakroom where you must deposit larger bags. However, no suitcases can be handed in. At the Vintage Club we cannot let you in with suitcases or large bags as the wardrobe is very limited.

DRESS CODE

In order to do justice to the atmosphere of the evening events, we ask that you dress appropriately: appropriate clothing of the 20s to 50s or elegant clothes! We are sorry, but expensive designer T-shirts or designer sweat-pants don't count. If you are not dressed appropriately, you may not be allowed in.

HEALTH CARE

If you got a cold, you cannot attend courses and events. Even if you have been looking forward to the festival for so long, think about your health and the health of others. Do not risk heart muscle inflammation and do not carelessly infect others! Better to do without once than for a lifetime.

For general health protection, please wash your hands regularly and thoroughly! We have set up hand disinfection dispenser at the evening events. We recommend taking small disinfectant bottles with you for your own convenience and the dance classes.

HYGIENE

Perhaps the most important issue. Please take care of the shower in the morning. **Especially important: fresh breath.** We haven't had vampires in classes before, so there's no need to eat garlic before class. A strong smell of alcohol might be cool in the peer group, but it's not appropriate in the classes. **The trend is back to brushing your teeth several times** – mind you, per day. During cool and energetic hours, it is inevitable that your t-shirt will get wet. **Please bring enough fresh T-shirts to change into and fresh towels**. The T-shirt from the day before, which was only hanging on the balcony and has not yet seen the inside of a washing machine, does not pass as fresh in Bavaria. :-) Handkerchiefs may only be used once by law! ;-) Make your mother proud!

COMPETITIONS

If places are still available, registration is also possible during the day at check-in and in the evening on site. If too few participants are registered for a tournament, the preliminary round can be omitted or the tournament can be cancelled. Registration in the evening closes 30 minutes before the start of the tournament. **Attention! The preliminary rounds for Fast Feet contests are already at the beginning of the evening.**

PRIVATE LESSONS

Even if you don't take part in the dance camp, you can arrange private lessons directly with the teachers. The Lenbachzimmer in the Künstlerhaus is available for private lessons from Thursday to Sunday during the regular Dance Camp times. The room rental is 20 Euro per hour. For a private lesson, please contact the relevant trainer.

DIESEL DRIVING BAN

In February, the gradual diesel driving ban in Munich came into force. In general, vehicles with emission standard 4/IV and worse are no longer allowed to enter downtown Munich. Please find out more about the details online.

On Saturday and Sunday Deutsches Theater offers a reduced price in the Contipark Stachus Tiefgarage underground car park (Herzog-Wilhelm-Straße 11, 80331 Munich). Please check at deutsches-theater.de for details.
